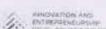

She said that Sexual violence is a widespread problem. It happens in every community and affects people of all genders and ages. Nearly one in five women and one in 71 men are victims of rape. Sexual violence is defined as any sexual activity where consent is not freely given. Even for those of us who don't directly experience it, we are all impacted by sexual -violence because of how it affects communities and society especially survivors and their loved ones. The program lasted for one hour. Additionally, it's important to listen and communicate without judgment. If they seek medical attention or make plans to report the assault, offer to be there for them and provide a supportive presence. Encourage the victim to get support from resources such as hotlines and sexual violence awareness/prevention organizations ,49 students attended.
